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# **Early Warning System - Background**

- First talks within EU / Russian Energy Dialogue starting 2013
  - > Russia proposed the concept of a European Dispatching Service
    - > Might be an idea for the future
  - > ENTSOG Board approved the further involvement in the discussion
    - Understood as an Early Warning System (EWS)
- Three meetings took place within the WS3
  - > Involvement of ENTSOG, Gazprom and other stakeholders
  - Solution > Gazprom welcomed the development of the EWS
  - > Start for a further cooperation





## **Early Warning System - Objectives**

- A broader vision of all gas flows entering EU member states
- > Support European TSOs and EU to
  - enhance the level of Security of Supply in crisis situations
  - provide an overview of the gas supply flows
- > Situation before EWS
  - No centralized EU TSO information
  - Broader coordination might be missing in case of crisis situations
- > EWS Proposal
  - Install an Early Warning Team
    - to facilitate information exchange under abnormal cases of flows
    - to agree on mitigating actions
    - o according to existing **EU law**, **national laws** and 3<sup>rd</sup> package philosophy.
- For later: Further development to other supply routes to EU
- Cooperation with 3<sup>rd</sup> countries from the Energy Community as well





# **Early Warning System - Functioning**

### Early Warning Team with different tools

- > Early Warning Team East (EWT-E) installed since September 2014
  - 16 TSOs including all taking in Russian gas directly or via non-EU countries
  - In addition Ukrtransgaz
- > Coordinator for the EWT-E
  - Fixed telephone number
  - 24/7 reachability
  - Getting the EWT-E assembled within about one hour
    - Virtual meeting room via Webex
    - Working on possible short term solutions
- > Tools
  - Swaps
  - Re-directing of gas
  - Extra capacity
  - Etc.





### Win-Win for Gazprom and EU-TSOs

#### Gazprom

- > Early information about gas supply or gas transmission problems in EU
- > Participates in resolving energy security of supply in EU in general
- > Business continuity in case of technical problems

#### European TSOs

- > Early information about gas supply or gas transmission problems in Russia
- Reliable energy supply for Europe
- Support from Gazprom to EU in case of supply problems from other sources

### Beneficial effect for all

- > Gazprom is seen as a **reliable energy supplier** for Europe
- > Enhancing a long term partnership and good cooperation between EU and Russia



### **Ukrainian Monitoring Mission**




### Established under EC chair 3rd and 4th quarter 2014

- > Term of Reference were set up
  - Signed by Ukrtransgaz
  - Gazprom informed
- > Main objective:
  - Set up a daily report with all the gas flows
  - Provide the daily report to all involved Parties
    - EC, Ukrtransgaz, Gazprom and relevant EU TSOs

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# Win-Win to have Gazprom on-board EWS

### Problem on the gas supply to EU production side in Russia

- > ENTSOG can provide the telephone number of the EWT-E coordinator to Gazprom
- > Gazprom can give an early warning to the coordinator of the EWT-E
  - EWT-E, Gazprom and other stakeholders can work on possible solutions

#### <u>Problem on the production side of other main supply corridors</u>

- > Other main suppliers (e.g. Statoil) will also know coordinator telephone number
- > Other main suppliers can give an early warning to EWT-E coordinator or other EWTs
- > All partners including Gazprom can discuss possible short- and long-term solutions

### <u>Problem with one of the main transport routes</u>

- > The affected TSO can call the coordinator
- > All partners including Gazprom can work on possible short- and long-term solutions



### **Ukrainian Monitoring Mission**



### Established under the chair of the EC in the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> quarter 2014

- Term of Reference were set up: Signed by Ukrtransgaz, Gazprom informed
- Main objectives:
  - Set up a daily report on all the gas flows
    - Gas from Russia to Ukraine
      - For domestic market in Ukraine
      - For transit to EU countries
    - Taking into account
      - Nominations from the Russian side
      - Nominations from Ukrtransgaz
      - Nominations from the relevant EU countries
      - Physical flows
  - Provide the daily report to all partners involved
    - EC, Ukrtransgaz, Gazprom and relevant EU TSOs



# **Early Warning Team East EWTE**



#### Members

- Open to all TSOs taking in Russian gas
- In addition NET4GAS

#### Coordinator

- To summon EWT-E in case of need
- Annual rolling basis
- Communication exercises

### Responsibility

- Affected TSO decides to call for EWT-E
- TSO calling for EWTE to chair the EWT-E
